BIAS AT THE ASSEMBLY

The Citizens' Assembly is fast approaching the conclusion of its work and will shortly be making a recommendation to the Oireachtas on whether or not to hold a referendum on the Eighth Amendment. The list of groups to address the Assembly at the next session has now been released. The Pro Life Campaign has been selected as one of the groups and we are currently working on our presentation. But this will not go any way near addressing the shocking imbalance that we have seen in the process so far.

Billed as an impartial review of the Eighth Amendment, the Assembly has instead presented an almost completely one-sided and biased view of this life-saving provision. Disgracefully, it has heard presentations from groups such as the British Pregnancy Advisory Service (BPAS), Britain's largest abortion provider who opposed any restrictions on abortion in England, including even a ban on sex selection abortions which specifically target baby girls.

Overall, the presentations to the Assembly have been mostly framed in a way that looks like the Eighth Amendment is on trial. The case for keeping the Amendment and the stories of the lives saved by it have been largely ignored.

Likewise the stories of families who felt pressured to abort their baby with a life-limiting condition and now regret the decision have been sidelined.

It is **essential** that this one-sided process is not allowed to be used as a basis for bringing a referendum on the Eighth Amendment.

Calling all people who care about protecting life, Sadly Our Country has possibly one last opportunity to protect those who cannot protect themselves..
