Prayer for Victims of Sexual Abuse by members of the Church

Following the request of Pope Francis to the Irish bishops to hold a day of prayer for people who have been abused by members of the Church, we in the Diocese of Kilmore are organizing a prayer service dedicated to those who have been abused and their families.

The prayer service will take place on Good Friday, 14th April in the Cathedral of St Patrick and St Felim, Cavan. It will take the form of 'Prayer Around the Cross', from 9pm to 10pm. This prayer is for those abused by members of the Church but all are welcome and we encourage everyone to attend to show support and solidarity.

Each parish will be asked to send representatives.

Abortion Group Forced to Return Illegal Soros Grant

The Abortion Rights Campaign has returned \$24,999 to the US-based Open Societies Foundation after an intervention by the Standards in Public Office Commission. The money from the George Soros-funded foundation was for a campaign to get rid of Ireland's constitutional protection for the unborn. Two other pro-abortion groups have refused to return over €250,000 of Soros money given for the same purpose .
