Please pray for **Fr. Charlie Heerey** retired parish priest Ballinamore whose funeral Mass takes place Sunday at 2pm in Belturbet. Fr. Charles was born on 6<sup>th</sup> December 1940. He was ordained a priest in St. Patrick's College Maynooth on 19<sup>th</sup> June 1966. He served a curate in Killargue from 1966 – 1968. He was appointed Bursar in St. Patrick's College Cavan in 1968, and subsequently Dean in 1973 and Spiritual Director in 1979.

In 1987 he went to Aughnasheelin as curate, before being appointed Parish Priest in Carrigallen. He was appointed Parish priest in Ballinamore, as in 2000 and his final appointment was to Annagh parish, where he served as curate in Belturbet until his death.
