John Paul II Awards Sunday 8th of October 2017

Over 100 young people from 11 parishes throughout the Diocese received awards on Friday last in Cavan Crystal Hotel. The number receiving the awards has doubled in the last number of years and it is great to see a number of new parishes coming on board each year.

The Awards are aimed at 16-18 Year Olds or anyone who has completed their Junior Certificate. The award consists of doing one hour per week in the parish and one hour per week in the community. The number of weeks determines the level of the Award. It is an excellent project for the Pastoral Council in a parish to take on and those parishes who have adopted this approach have been very successful.

Young People have described completing the Awards in the following way: ‘great sense of achievement, getting to know new people, realising the preparation that goes into different activities, making new friends, having more of an interest in going to mass and meeting people of different ages. It seems to be a very worthwhile activity.
