Mc Govern builder of subways, dies.

Boring of \$43,000,000 Tunnel Climax of Career Begun with Shovel

Patrick Mc Govern subway and tunnel builder extraordinary, died yesterday at his home, Harbour Knoll, King's Point, Great Neck Long Island from a cerebral hemorrhage after a brief illness, he was 62 years old.

Mr. Mc Govern was born in County Cavan Ireland. In 1891, when twenty years old he came to this country to seek his fortune, landing in Boston and quickly finding himself a pick-and-shovel job.

After working as a labourer for a few years he joined in the Alaska Gold Rush (1896). He did not find much gold but he said in later years he did acquire, while a miner, much practical engineering knowledge which stood him in good stead afterwards.

Tool Shed for First Office

Returning to Boston he went into the contracting business for himself, his headquarters being a small tool shed. His business grew and his reputation spread. One of the jobs which brought him into the limelight was the construction of part of the Boston subway.

Twenty five years ago in search of wider fields he came to New York. Since then he has confined his firm's activities to large subway and tunnel jobs.

Among his achievements was the Fifty-third St. Tunnel of the city's subway system a \$22,000,000 job. He also constructed a \$14,000,000 section of the Philadelphia Subway.

His greatest enterprise however was the city's new water tunnel No. 2 which stretches twenty five miles from the Yonkers line through the Bronx under the East River, through Queens and terminates in Brooklyn.

The Mc Govern firm won the contract for this tube to be carved through the solid rock hundreds of feet underneath the street level with a bid of \$43,000,000. The task was not scheduled to be completed until 1935, but it now is nearly done. The work has taken a toll of more than fifty lives.
